



Old Dominion Named to Inbound Logistics' G75 List *Company honored for commitment to supply chain sustainability*

THOMASVILLE, N.C. (July 6, 2016) – *Inbound Logistics* has named Old Dominion Freight Line, Inc. to its 75 Green Supply Chain Partners (G75) 2016 list.

This is Old Dominion's sixth consecutive year receiving the honor, which recognizes companies for their commitment to supply chain sustainability.

The annual list, which is featured in the special "Lean and Green" June issue of the magazine, was compiled to showcase companies that demonstrate green best practices in supply chain, logistics and transportation operations. The results are based on four main criteria: measureable green results, sustainability innovation, continuous improvement and industry recognition.

"As we mark this achievement, Old Dominion will continue to seek out ways to reduce emissions and improve fuel efficiency across our global network," said Tom Newby, VP of Equipment and Maintenance for Old Dominion. "Sustainability initiatives are essential to keeping our promise to our customers, communities and investors."

In recent years, Old Dominion has invested substantially in environmental programs. Trailers are equipped with aerodynamic side skirts – a move that resulted in fuel reduction for the company, and fully equipped with technology, like onboard computers that track MPG. In the past year, these changes improved Old Dominion's MPG by 2.1%.

In addition, every new service center is equipped with LED lights, and many existing service centers are being retro fitted with LEDs. The company installed a 1.8 megawatt Solar PV system on the roof of a warehouse near its Thomasville, N.C. headquarters.

The company's Canton, Ohio, Service Center opened as the first LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certified facility in its nationwide network. The resource efficient building uses less water, energy and reduces greenhouse gas emissions.

Old Dominion is certified through the U.S. EPA SmartWay Program, proving to implement and optimize technology changes to significantly improve fleet fuel mileage performance.
