EXCEPTIONS TO NMFC  
CLASSIFICATION OF ARTICLES

1. When the National Motor Freight Classification publishes a "0" rating for a commodity, the applicable rating shall be Class 500.
2. When the National Motor Freight Classification publishes a "not taken" provision, shipments inadvertently picked up and handled by ODFL shall be rated at Class 500.

EXCEPTIONS TO NMFC  
CLASSIFICATION OF DOORS, DOORS IN FRAMES OR DOOR FRAMES WITH OR WITHOUT DOORS SHIPPED UPRIGHT ON PALLETS OR SKIDS

Doors, doors in frames or door frames with or without doors, shipped upright on pallets or skids will receive a classification for rating purposes based on the following density scale:

Determine the cube of each pallet or skid.

EXAMPLE: L40" X W48" X H82" / 1728 = 91.11 cubic feet.

Calculate the density by dividing the weight of the shipment by the cubic feet.

EXAMPLE: Weight of shipment 600 pounds / 91.1 cu. ft. = 6.6 pounds per cubic foot.

The classification to be used for rating purposes will be taken from the following scale:

---

DENSITY RANGE IN POUNDS PER CUBIC FOOT	CLASS
Less than 2	300
2 but less than 4	250
4 but less than 6	150
6 but less than 8	125
8 or greater	85
