ITEM 821

BLIND SHIPMENT AND SHIPMENT COORDINATION

A charge of:

\$55.00

will apply to any shipment when a third party requires ODFL to act as the intermediary in instances when the shipper is unaware of the true destination and/or the consignee is unaware of the true origin (Often referred to as a "Blind Shipment"). The service includes coordination of multiple bills of lading and directing the shipment the shipment at the origin terminal as instructed by the requestor. For the purpose of this item a requestor is the owner of the goods or someone authorized to act on behalf of the owner of the goods.

1. Only requests prior to pick up will be considered for this service.
 2. Requestor must complete and fax form "Blind Shipment Coordination" and a through bill of lading.
 3. ODFL must be satisfied that the requestor has the legal authority to control the shipment.
 4. The above charge will apply in addition to all other applicable charges.
 5. ODFL will accept the shipment when tendered by the party in possession and issue a bill of lading to move the shipment to requestor at the ODFL origin terminal. The bill of lading received via fax from the requestor will apply from the ODFL origin terminal to the final consignee and destination.
 6. Charges and provisions of Item 580 (Marking or Tagging Freight) will apply if re-labeling of the shipment is required.
 7. Charges for this service and applicable line-haul charges must be billed Prepaid and paid by the party requesting the service.
