ITEM 995

APPLICATION OF PALLET WEIGHT EXCLUSION

1. When pricing provisions established for the payor of charges provide for the exclusion of pallet weight from the weight upon which freight charges are assessed, a pallet weight of 40 pounds per pallet will be used unless otherwise provided.
  2. All weights shown on the bill of lading shall be deemed to be products weights, only, unless shipper specifically designates the weight of the pallets.
  3. When shipments are reweighed by ODFL and such breakdown of pallet weight is not listed on the original bill of lading, a tolerance of 40 pounds per pallet (or otherwise negotiated value) will be subtracted from the total verified weight when determining if the weight on the original bill of lading is in error.
